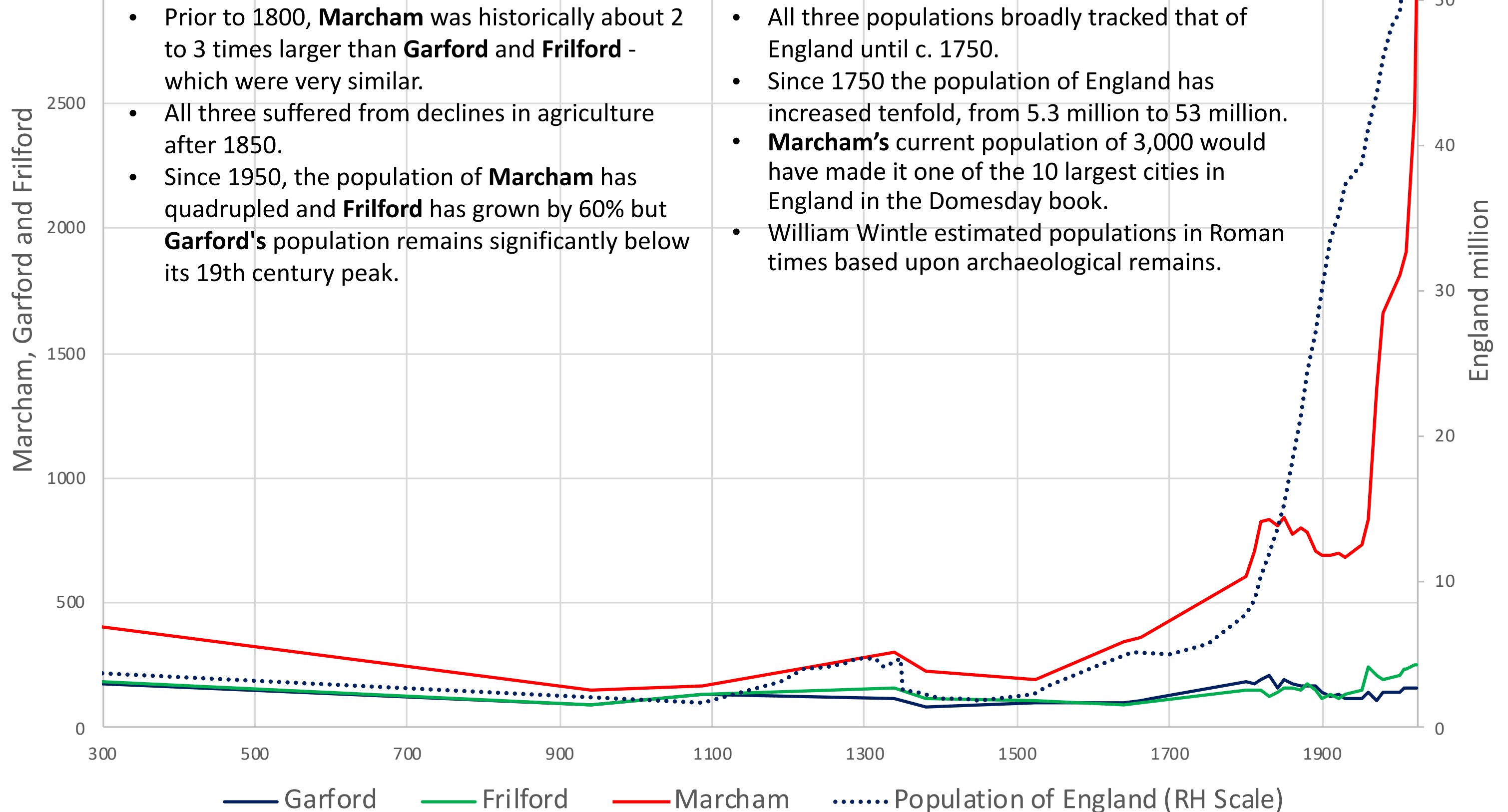


Populations of Marcham, Garford and Frilford and England 300 AD to 2025



Population of Garford, Frilford and Marcham

Garford's population reached its peak of 209 in the 1831 census. That marked the start of a long period of population decline, to 112 in 1971.

Frilford's population peaked at 178 in 1881 and declined to 113 in 1921. It then grew again to 248 today.

Marcham's population peaked at 845 in 1851

and declined to 685 in 1931 before growing rapidly after WW2 to reach 3,000 today. Since 1950, the population of **Marcham** has quadrupled.

Frilford's has grown by 60% but **Garford** remains significantly below its 19th century peak.
